



In 2018, the Montana FFA Foundation celebrated our 20th anniversary. Over the course of the past two decades, our Foundation has grown from just an idea and has blossomed into a support mechanism for our over 5,000 Montana FFA members in 97 local FFA chapters by raising over \$400,000, annually.

As we look back on this milestone, we want to recognize all of our donors, both new and those who have been with us since the beginning, for investing in Agricultural Education and developing future Montana leaders. Through your generous donations, we are able to impact FFA members in the following ways:

Leadership Development - FFA offers a wide variety of opportunities for leadership development and personal growth in our FFA members. Our Montana FFA members participate in career-focused contests, leadership workshops and sessions, and learn about career opportunities from our partners at events held throughout the year including the State FFA Convention, District Leadership Seminars, John Deere Ag Expo, the Agricultural Opportunities Tour, and Torgerson's GOLD Conference.

Personal Growth through Scholarships and Grants – Expanding from our Bulls for Blue grant that provides funds to FFA members who wish to start or expand their Beef Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE), the Montana FFA Foundation has begun awarding SAE grants in any area from Ag Communications to Repair & Maintenance for students who are seeking to develop these entrepreneurial work-based learning projects.

• Local Chapter Support – We continue to provide funds for service projects for FFA chapters to give back to their communities. For the first year, the Montana FFA Foundation has also begun supporting Agricultural Education teachers' needs in the classroom including curriculum, instructional equipment and technology, and professional development through our new Emerge Education program.

It is clear that the hard work and commitment from our supporters throughout our history has allowed the idea of providing additional support in developing the next general of Montana leaders to come to fruition. However, we still have much work to do. Our vision continues to look for ways to sustain and grow our support for Montana's young leaders over the next 20 years. Your support is integral in continuing to provide resources to meet the needs for leadership development, personal growth, and local chapter support for all schools in the Montana FFA Association.





PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT State Officer Continuum

Following election, state officers embark on a journey of growth, leadership, and service directed through 11 key areas of focus. While each state's journey features customized variations, the National FFA Organization supports states and their officers through a blended learning model including face-to-face training experiences, digital/print resources, and online education through the State Officer Academy - all of this to guide in the development of world-ready leaders.



Initial Training (Montana Only) - Officers learn about what their year of service will entail, and meet with numerous stakeholders. During this time, officers will also be briefed on media communication, goal setting, and create the theme for Montana FFA's coming year.

Base C11amp - Base Camp is a standard three-day experience for all state FFA officers. Focus areas include sound character, positive influence, professionalism, and time management. Additionally, this experience enrolls students into the entire State Officer Leadership Continuum and the State Officer Academy learning management system.

Checkpoint - Checkpoints include up to two additional in-state training experiences. These experiences can cover the following focus areas: successful workshops, public speaking, conversation skills, and team dy-namics.

State Officer Summit - Held in Washington D.C. each July, this three-day advocacy training experience that is open to all 375 state FFA officers. Training will focus on serving as an advocate for agriculture and FFA, as well as developing clear and consistent messages related to agriculture and FFA.


