All FFA Chapters, especially those on reservations, are encouraged to compete in this awards program by having their members:

- a. Research their heritage or the heritage of a tribe in Montana
- b. Prepare a visual program on their heritage or heritage of a tribe
- c. Present a 10-15 minute documentary on their heritage or heritage of a tribe

Each team is required to present their program to a their school boards, parents or communities and can be virtually. Each participant will also present their program to the delegates at the State FFA Convention. The delegates and/or evaluation committee will vote and determine the winner.

The winning Chapter is encouraged to showcase their presentation at the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana.
